Children and youth

We are able to accommodate small groups of children for Children's Church. Children need to sit with their parents for worship until they are released. Parents will be responsible for taking their children to the mall bathrooms. Should your child need the bathroom during the service, you will be notified via a message on the screen. There will be no Youth during the services. We are planning other events at the venue for Unshaken Youth and the Young Covenanters.

When you arrive at church

Please arrive from 9:45 onwards, so that we can take your temperature. Please cooperate with the ushers at all times. Make sure you are scanned and that you sanitise your hands every time you enter the venue.

Like many things at church this year, our children's ministry took on a different look and feel. We all got used to having classes online, after the service. The team found their feet with the technology and our children got used to engaging over a screen. While it was initially a little challenging and hard to only connect with each class every four weeks, we can look back now on the amazing times we had online. Our parents also became more involved on a Sunday morning, using the material sent each week to have their own 'Children's Church' at home. Well done to the team, the children and the parents for persevering with children's ministry during this time. **'Toby stickers for you all!'**

And now it is time for a new season! Both the children's church team and the children are so excited to soon be meeting together in person. Even with masks and Covid-19 protocols, we can't wait to connect again around God's Word.

Things will be a little different, so please take note of the following:

- When you register for church on a Sunday, remember to register your children. The system will ask you which age group or class your children fall into. Simply tick the relevant group.
- Our classroom sizes are small, and we will be following Covid-19 protocols, so we will only be able to take small groups of children in each age group – so book early.
- Children need to wear masks, except for the very youngest if they are unable to do so.
- We will be sanitising hands and surfaces. And even though we still want to teach our children to share, we won't be doing this at children's church. Each child will have access to an individual set of stationery (pencils, crayons, etc.) and the younger ones won't be sharing toys.
- The children will be with their parents/caregivers for worship, going to children's church after the offering.
- Children aged 5 and younger will not have a seat during worship (before going to children's church), so will need to stand/sit with his/her parent. We apologise for this, but due to Covid-19 protocols, we don't have space for extra chairs.
- To accommodate those who are unable to attend children's church, and to assist our parents with discipleship material, we will continue to send out our weekly email containing the lesson summary, Bible Story videos and more.

So, book your space, put on your mask, sanitise your hands, and we will see you on Sunday!
