WEEK OF PRAYER AND FASTING

Our God is an awesome God. Our annual week of prayer, fasting and consecration was an incredible time of seeking God's face, of bringing our requests before the throne-room of grace and of standing in faith for breakthroughs in lives and in our community.

It was amazing to have so many people joining us for prayer each night during this week, crying out for more of God. **Our strong sense after this week is that God is at work and is preparing the soil for an incredible time of revival.** We know that He is at work in the hearts of people. As we consecrated our lives to Him, we now look to Him for what is still to come. Come, Holy Spirit, come! Many of you shared a prophetic sense or vision with us during this time. Lisa Branson had a dream, which she describes below, which tells of what we believe God is doing in our midst at this time.

“ I had a dream. I was in a school classroom and Pastor Dennis was speaking to the church on a live stream about godly people trusting Jesus in the workplace and businesses. There was a lot of noise in the background. I didn't know what I was doing there and felt totally out of my depth, so I started praying in tongues. There was a chalk board with writing on it and next to it were photographs of people. When I looked closer, I recognised some of the people and God said that these are people of success. When I tried to read the writing on the board, I couldn't see it at all, no matter how close I went to it. Pastor Dennis then put the microphone in front of me and I had the impression that I had to speak, but I was frozen in fear. I started to stress because I knew I couldn't see the writing on the board. What was I supposed to say? I looked down and I was no longer in the classroom, but standing on a mountain, a precipice. All I could see was blackness. I was paralyzed by fear, knowing that stepping off that cliff would surely be suicide. God said to me, stop focusing on the cloud of doubt and fear and darkness. Look up! I did this and suddenly I saw a bridge. The first part was covered in mist, but as my eyes focused more on the bridge, it slowly started getting lighter and brighter, until all I could see was sunshine and Jesus standing on the other side.

I asked God what this all meant and He said:

- The classroom represents where people have studied and been trained.
- The writing you couldn't see is like faith. Faith shows the reality of what we hope for, it is the evidence of things we cannot see. You must trust in what you've learned and achieved in the classroom. He has given you your skills and abilities and will help you remember it all when you need to make business decisions.
- The darkness of the mountain cliff is when you are faced with doubt and fear in how to run your business and honour God in it, how to succeed and how to survive in the world. Don't focus on the darkness, but focus on Jesus. He promises to lead you and guide you in all you entrust into His hands.

"Your word is a lamp for my feet, a light on my path." Psalm 119:105






Church in this season
